Our Raven Offices are excited to be offering a variety of in person workshops for the 2021-2022 school year. We know how important these face-to-face opportunities are to our students and families. We enjoy being able to connect with each other and hearing of all your homeschool successes.

While we work hard to meet the needs of every student, Raven must also continue to prioritize the collective health and safety of all our students, staff, and communities. Due to the circulating and highly contagious Delta variant, updated guidance from CDC, medical community updates, and input from our families and staff, Raven will be revising our mask requirements.

Effective immediately and for the next 30 days:

K-12 Workshops and Activities: Raven will require masks for all staff, students, and parents while attending Raven sponsored K-12 workshops and activities indoors.

ILP Meetings: Masks will be encouraged, but will remain optional, for staff and families during ILP meetings.

Outdoor Activities: For Raven sponsored outdoor activities, Raven will follow the local mitigation guidelines for masks and social distancing. If in a congregate setting and where social distancing is not feasible, then masks will be required for Raven participants.

Virtual Options: Options to attend meetings and most activities online or virtually are available and can be scheduled at your local offices.

We look forward to your continued participation and hope that with these added measures we can return to face to face activities without masks soon. We appreciate all you do to support your Raven community. I encourage you to continue to provide your input to your local Parent Advisory Committees and attend the Raven-wide PAC scheduled for October 27th for further updates. We will be revisiting our mitigation plan in 30 days to ensure we are meeting the needs of our students and families while continuing to keep our communities safe and healthy.
